Technology....

Our school has 2 computer labs which house 30 computers each. The students receive computer lab twice a month as part of their specials rotations. In addition, Creek View has 2 iPad carts and 6 laptop carts that can be used within the classroom. Each classroom is equipped with desktop computers as well as an interactive white board or projector.
