Libraries Rock Summer Reading Program (June 1-August 1) Ages 3-12

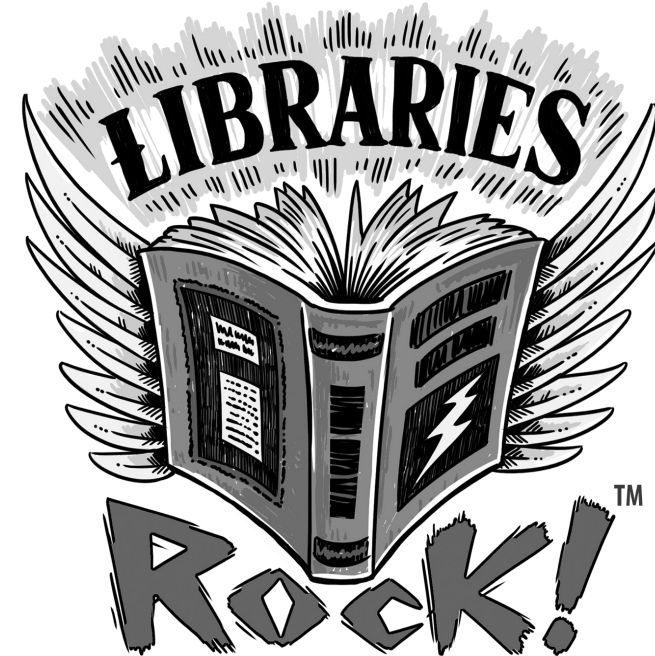
