The Georgia Milestones Assessment System (Georgia Milestones) is a comprehensive assessment system that measures how well students in grades 3 – 5 have learned the knowledge and skills outlined in the state-adopted content standards in English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies. Please be sure your child eats a healthy breakfast and arrives to school on time **as all testing sessions begin promptly at 8:00am**. Please note the specific grade level schedule listed below for April 12th – 24th.
