**3rd-5th Grade
Literacy Goal**

- Proficient or distinguished scores will increase to 45%: 3rd grade, 45%: 4th grade and 50%: 5th grade on the Georgia Milestone Assessment in May 2020.

Math Goal

- Proficient or distinguished scores will increase to 40%: 3rd grade, 35%: 4th grade and 45% : 5th grade on the Georgia Milestone Assessment in May 2020.

- Math Fluency

As a School, Evoline C. West will:

- Provide families with technology based resources such as iRead and iReady which supports reading comprehension and fluency.
- Provide a Parent Resource Center for families to check out math and reading resources to support their children at home.
- Provide families with the iReady Math website to access at home to improve math skills.
- Offer our families Family Engagement Workshops that will provide daily real-world problem solving using fractions, addition, subtraction and etc. in cooking and money management.

- Encourage my child to use iRead, iReady, and iReady Math to increase his or her reading comprehension, fluency and math skills.
- Visit the Parent Resource Center to access materials to use at home with my child to help them in the areas of Math and Reading.
- Attend the Family Engagement Workshops that will provide daily real-world problem solving activities geared for the whole family.

As an Evoline C. West Student, I will:

- Use websites such as iRead, iReady, and iReady Math to self- monitor my progress and increase my reading comprehension, fluency and math skills.
- Use materials from the Parent Resource Center such as books, games, and flashcards to support the things I learned in class.
- I will attend the interactive workshops with my family to help me with real-world problem solving.
