## School Goals

- **Math Proficiency** – The percentage of students in 3rd-5th grades, performing at developing or above on the Georgia Milestones, will increase by 3% from 62% to 65% for the 2019-2020 school year.
  - *The focus will be on improving students' conceptual understanding of how to solve problems across all math domains.*
- **Literacy Proficiency** – The percentage of students in 3rd-5th grades, performing at developing or above on the Georgia Milestones, will increase by 4% from 56% to 60% for the 2019-2020
  - *The focus will be on phonics.*

## Teachers, Parents, and Students – Together for Success

### As a school, we will:

- Provide parents with academic workshops that focus on strategies to increase reading comprehension and fluency as well as basic math computation skills.
- Encourage parents to read daily with their students for 30 minutes using reading logs.
- Provide a Parent Resource Center where parents can check out reading and math resources.

### As parents, we will:

- Attend Title I academic workshops that focus on strategies to help my child with reading and math at home.
- Read with my child daily for 30 minutes using reading logs.
- Visit the Parent Resource Center where I may check out reading and math resources to help my child at home.

### As students, we will:

- Ask for extra help when I do not understand my math and reading activity.
- Take my reading log home and read with my parents for 30 minutes daily.
- Use the reading and math materials my parents check out of the Parent Resource Center.
