Principal's Welcome: Greetings to all of our Ison Springs families! The educational team at ISES is excited to welcome you to the new year. We have some amazing programming and activities in store for our students and families this school year and are thrilled to be working collaboratively with all of you! The students have been acclimating to their new teachers and classrooms extremely well and are already on the road to success. Carpool Procedure & Safety Concerns

We encourage all students to ride the school bus if possible. However, we understand many parents prefer to bring their child to school and drop them off in the car pool line. Beginning at 7:15am (per the school clock) we will have staff members assist your child as they exit from the car. During that time we ask that you be patient and do not allow your child to exit your car unless they are instructed to do so by the staff present. Students should not exit the car until the car has reached the sidewalk area. At 7:40 am the instructional day starts for students and staff and carpool is no longer supervised. Parents arriving after 7:40 should park their car and accompany their child to the front office to sign the child in for the day. This ensures your child will enter the building safely.



When driving on our campus, we ask that you remain respectful and have the safety of your child and other children in mind. **Please never allow your child to cross the circle in front of other cars, walk in front of other cars or let them out on Ison Road.**

Student Agenda's

We will be using student agenda's to communicate between home/school this year. As soon as our agenda shipment arrives each student will receive an agenda for use for homework assignments, projects and home/school communications. Thank you for your patience.



Change Of Transportation & Student Check-Out

In the next few weeks we will begin using an online dismissal for all students. Parents will be able to make transportation changes through this system. Until we get this system up and running this school year, if your student is to go home in a different manner the parent/guardian may submit the change in writing to the homeroom teacher. All changes must be made prior to 12:00 pm For security/safety reasons **"Call-in" dismissal changes are not accepted.** Students will not be released to a parent from the classroom. All students must be checked out from the Front Office. **Anyone checking out a student is required to provide a valid ID as proof of identity.** Only persons **listed** as emergency contacts (18 years or older) in eSchool (the student information system) will be permitted to check out students. Any changes to student records, including adding additional contacts approved to check out students must be sent to our data clerk in writing. **In order to avoid disruptions to the dismissal process no student check-out will be allowed after 2:00pm.**
