Kindergarten

20:1 (Full-Time Assistant)

Currently, we have 6 kindergarten homerooms and are projected to have 6 classes next year.



Arrival

- Breakfast and/or Get Fit Program before coming to the classroom
- Students unpack and get ready for the day
- Early Morning Activities
- Explorer Vision Northwood's Morning Announcements
- Morning Meeting and Calendar right after announcements

Morning Meeting and Calendar

- During Morning Meeting we do the following:
 - "Get to know each other" activities
 - Student Shares
 - Building Classroom Community activities
- During Calendar time sight words and sounds are used in discussions and calendar activities.

Writing

- Writer's Workshop
- Teachers model the writing process and guide students so they begin writing independently
- Teachers conference with students focusing on individual strengths and weakness



Reading/Language Arts

- Focus on Georgia Standards of Excellence
- Harcourt Reading and Language Arts Series
- Small group instruction includes reading strategies, basic decoding, fluency, and comprehension strategies
- Integrated Social Studies and Science standards are taught through reading and language arts

Science/Social Studies/Health

- Science Harcourt Science series
 - Focus on hands-on experiences both in the classroom and our Science Lab
- Social Studies New Resources coming in 2019-2020
 - Large portion of our units focus around holidays and traditions as well as important people.
- Health Harcourt "Your Health" series
 - Focus on keeping our body healthy and safe.

■ Art and Music — once a week



- PE twice a week
- Computer Lab twice a month
- Media Center Lessons once a month
- Guidance Lessons once month







Lunch

- Our cafeteria provides hot lunches with a variety of choices
- This year's lunch price is \$2.45 (breakfast costs \$1.10)
- You may pre-pay and add money to your child's account for lunch and/or breakfast – there are two accounts – GENERAL and MEAL
- Parents are welcome to have lunch with their children AFTER the first two weeks of school at our visitor's table
- Please help us by teaching your children to open containers and other lunch items

Recess

- Children have recess every day for at least 30 minutes
- This is an opportunity to build relationships with friends.



Math

- Number Talks focus on various math skills such as number sense, place value, skip counting, patterns, sequencing, etc.
- Focus on Georgia Standards of Excellence
- McGraw Hill "My Math" Math Series
- Many hands-on experiences, problem solving and students explaining their math thinking.
- Small group instruction focuses on individual student needs.

SRA - Reading Mastery

- SRA is a phonics based reading program unique to Northwood.
- Students learn sounds and begin to blend them in order to read words and then sentences.
- These groups are based on where students are in the reading process and change throughout the year.

End of Day Activities, Pack-Up, Dismissal



REPORTING PROGRESS TO PARENTS

- Teachers communicate student progress throughout the year through conferences, phone calls, emails, etc.
- Formal parent/teacher conferences are held at the beginning of the year and as needed to discuss your child's progress.
- GKIDS reports are sent home three times throughout the year.
- Report cards are sent home four times throughout the year.
- Work folder and daily behavior progress sheet are sent home for your review and signature each day.

ASSESSMENT

- Teachers assess throughout the year using observation, student work and end of unit assessments.
- Kindergarten students are flexibly grouped throughout the year in order to best meet each child's needs.
- Georgia Kindergarten Inventory of Developing Skills (GKIDS)
 - Students are assessed throughout the year
 - A final report goes home in the spring
- Math and Language Arts standards are assessed throughout the year.




- Attendance/Tardies
