Dear Northwood Elementary School Governance Council,

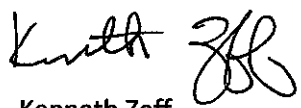

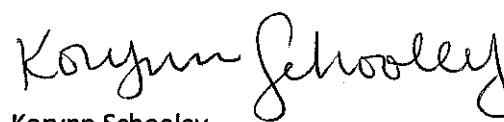
- a.) Approve the school strategic plan and updates
