

# Automatic Screening (Fall)

- **Standardized Achievement Tests** –
  - ≥ 85%ile **and** ≥ 90%ile on IOWA in **two** of the following areas:  
Total Reading, Total Math, **or** Complete Battery (*supporting data is needed*)
- **FastBridge Assessments**- (Fall administration for grades K-5)
  - ≥ 90%ile Grade K-Reading **and** Math (*no supporting data is needed*)
  - ≥ 90%ile Grades 1-5-Reading **or** Math (*supporting data is needed*)
- **Acceleration Assessments**- (most recent administration)
  - ≥ 80%ile Grade K - ELA **and** Mathematics (*no supporting data is needed*)
  - ≥ 80%ile Grades 1-3- ELA **or** Math (*supporting data is needed*)
- **Georgia Milestones End of Grade Assessment** -  
Achievement Level (4) for ELA **or** Math (*supporting data is needed*)

Supporting Evidence (if needed) in **at least 1** of these 4 areas:  
*Mental Ability*  
*Achievement*  
*Creativity*  
*Motivation*

There is **NO** supporting evidence

Does **not** meet the screening requirements

Student is referred for consideration for testing  
 (Notification of Consideration of Gifted Services is sent home)

Parental consent is **not** given

Parental consent **is** given *in writing*



Student is tested in needed area(s)

**Nationally Normed Tests/Scales**

**Mental Ability**-CogAT or NNAT (each given every two years)- ≥ 96%ile in **at least** one area to qualify  
**Achievement**-Stanford (given every two years) or IOWA (given in 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade)- ≥ 90%ile in reading, math, **or** total composite to qualify  
**Creativity**-TTCT or Creativity Product (each given every two years, alternating)- ≥ 90%ile to qualify  
**Motivation**-GRS-M (can be given every year)- ≥ 90%ile to qualify

Eligible through multiple criteria (3 of the 4 categories must be a qualifying score)

Eligible through mental ability (K-2 = 99%ile or 3-12 ≥ 96%ile Composite National Percentile Ranking) **plus** nationally normed achievement test score ≥ 90%ile

Not eligible this testing cycle
