

Frequently Asked Topics Student Microsoft Surface 3

Device User Agreements

For a student to be issued a device, a Device User Agreement must be signed by a parent and the student. As a parent, you can go to this link

<https://www.zippslip.com/ZippSlip/PermissionManager/GA/GA/Fulton+County+Public+Schools> to create a parent account and complete the Device User Agreement with your student.

If you already have a ZippSlip account for another student, you do not need to establish a new account, simply add your additional Cambridge student with their student I.D. number and birth date.

Opt-Out

If you do not want your student to receive a device, do not sign the Device User Agreement. By not signing this agreement you are opting out of your student receiving a device during distribution.

Agreement Deadline

For your student to receive a device on August 9, 2018, you must complete the Device User Agreement by the deadline of August 6, 2018 at 9:00 am. Students will receive a device during a make-up session the week of August 13 if agreements are signed after 9:00 am on August 6.

Fines

Your student will not be able to receive a device if they have outstanding fines or devices from the previous school year. This includes fines or checkouts from other Fulton County Schools. If you have questions about fines, please contact Laura Morgan, MorganL1@fultonschools.org.

Carrying Case

The devices come with a protective case already installed. Parents can purchase a protective sleeve or case for their child's device.

Device Damage, Loss, or Theft

If for any reason the device is lost, stolen or damaged during the time it is issued to the student, whether intentionally or due to negligence, the student and the student's parent/guardian are responsible for the appropriate fine. More information on the Microsoft Surface 3 fines can be found in the Device User Agreement.

Insurance

Parents can choose to purchase insurance for the device to cover damage or loss of device. For more information on repairs to devices through insurance companies, as well as an insurance company authorized to make repairs on Fulton County Schools issued devices, see the Device User Agreement.

Grace Period

We realize that the devices are on their third year of use and some damage may have been missed during Summer Clean. If you have any issues with the device or accessories that are assigned to you, please let us know in the Student Center as soon as possible! Any issues brought to our attention before August 31, 2018 will not be charged a fine.
