

AP EURO Suggested Biography Topics (in order of appearance)

Your summer project this year is going to be to create a biography on the person of your choice (only 1 person may do any one historical figure). Your project could be a PowerPoint or Keynote presentation; a one-person play or something else that can be presented to the class. Your presentation should be at least 20 - 25 minutes in length so think about that as you chose a topic and begin to prepare for it. The first **draft** for everyone's presentations will be due by Friday when we return from summer break. This could be just a title slide. You will present your biography during the time period in which they were alive. If you want to get it over with, pick someone early. If you don't want to do anything over summer, pick someone later. All presentations will be finished before the end of the first semester. If you would like to do a person that is not on the list, please contact me. You must get approval for someone that is not on this list. Please sign up before you leave for summer.** You will also need to acquire the AMSCO European History book. You do not need to read it, but you will need to purchase it.
