(2) Register for your selected course(s) online through the appropriate portal by the deadline (March 13th for Fulton Virtual and March 30th for GA Virtual). This flow chart <http://goo.gl/AUKSS3> may be helpful to follow. Students may register for a maximum of 2 half-credits per semester (1 semester course = 0.5 credit).
