Zero Period SAT/ACT Test Prep - Next Course begins Monday, Jan 14th and runs through Thursday, Feb 21st. These sessions meet in the mornings before school from 7:30-8:10 four days per week. Math sessions normally meet on Mondays and Wednesdays in Mr. Bennett's room, G106. English sessions normally meet on Tuesdays and Thursdays in Ms. Hayes' room, E105. Students accepted into the program are expected to be on time, attend regularly with no more than two absences, and invest between 5 to 10 hours per week in their preparation for the SAT/ACT outside of the Zero Period class time.
