# School Governance Council Minutes May 11, 2016

#### **Principal Report**

Mr. Corrigan reported about end of year items. Graduation is set for Verizon. He updated the council on hiring. The SPLOST vote is on the May 24<sup>th</sup>. He presented the information the district has provided to him about where/how the money would be spent for the county and for the school. Renovations and modifications from SPLOST proposed specifically Chattahoochee would include basic upgrades to the facility and improvements to our fine arts and physical education/athletic programs. He shared a video presented by the county for the Capital Plan 2022 which would be predicated on passage of SPLOST. All details are available on fultonschools.org/splost.

He gave a brief update of the construction. The plan is to get the work finalized over the summer and have a ribbon cutting ceremony in the fall.

AP testing will be over Friday. EOCs are basically over; there were some problems with the internet during the testing. It will be another "hold harmless" year as far as CCRPI and teacher evaluations and promotion/retention for elementary schools.

### **Review SGC survey results**

Deb shared the SGC survey results on the effectiveness of council. Overall, our scores were very strong (all in the 4 – out of 5 – range).

#### **Focus on RFFs**

We discussed some ideas for RFF proposals for next year. Ideas ranged from additional professional development time, adding a community service requirement for graduation. We also talked about how we might embed one course within another course for double credit (i.e., 11<sup>th</sup> grade lit standards embedded within an APUSH History course).
