



## HB 91 Response to Petition Inquiries

Greetings,

Thank you for contacting Fulton County Schools to inquire about House Bill 91. This law, passed on March 30, 2015, provides that Georgia students are no longer required to earn a passing score on any graduation tests to earn a high school diploma. Former students that did not earn a high school diploma solely for not achieving a passing score on any of the graduation tests, but met all other state requirements for their expected year of graduation may submit a petition to Fulton County Schools online to determine if they are eligible to receive their high school diploma. Please note that completion of the online petition is still required even if you have submitted a paper petition at a local school.
