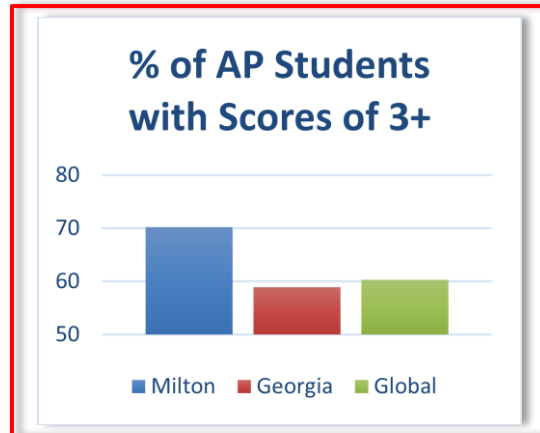

### 2017 AP scores:

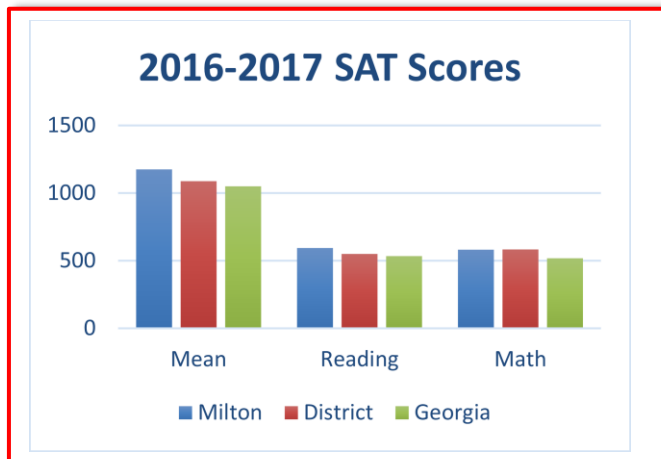
Nearly 70% of Milton's 2,031 AP students achieved a score of 3 or higher on their AP exams – well above state and global rates.

#### SAT scores:

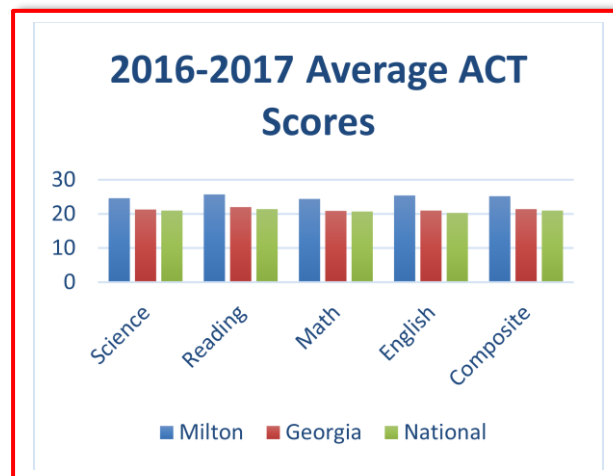
Milton scores greatly exceeded state and overall averages in Critical Reading, Mathematics and Writing.
