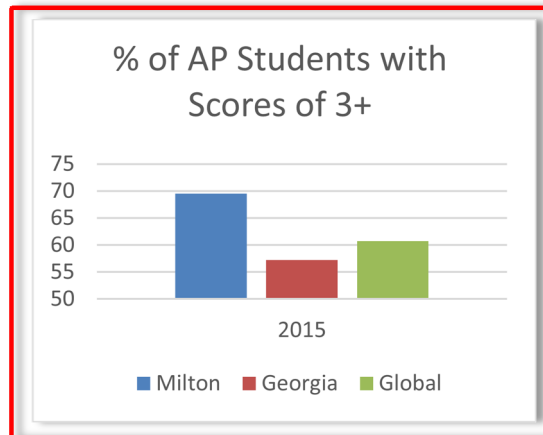

Nearly 70% of Milton's 1,008 AP students achieved a score of 3 or higher on their AP exams – well above state and global rates.



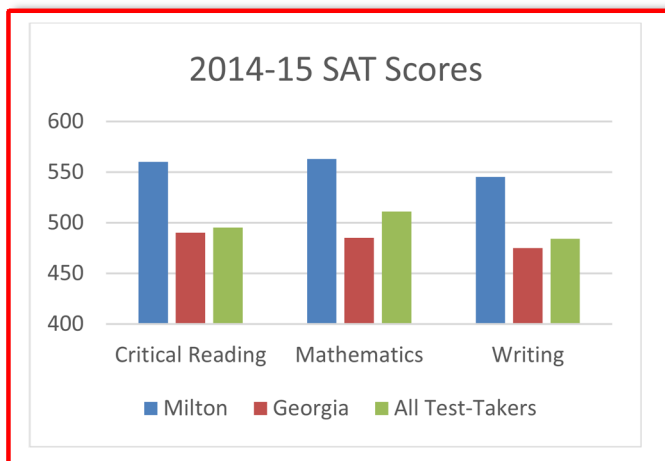
Fast Facts:
