

# Principal's Parent Update

Dear Parents,

- The North Springs Cluster of schools (Dunwoody Springs, Ison Springs, Spalding Drive, Woodland, Sandy Springs Middle & North Springs), have selected 4 release days for the 2017-2018 school year. Release days are student holidays/and teacher workdays for our staff to collaborate. The first release day is this Friday, 9/1. The remaining release days are: 11/17, 1/16, and 3/13, which fall before or after a holiday period, giving students and families in the cluster the same extended break.
- An important message for parents of 9<sup>th</sup> grade students that utilized the waiver for proof
  of residency during Gear Up Days. The 30-day waiver period for proof of residency is fast
  approaching. The deadline is Tuesday, 9/5. Please return the appropriate
  documentation of residency verification to school prior to the 9/5 deadline to
  ensure continued enrollment at North Springs.


