

Accolades for the Class of 2018

Did you know this senior class

- Has received in excess of \$6.2 million dollars in scholarship money. This is \$1.4 million more than last year's seniors.
- Has 343 students, out of 389, that have been accepted to a technical college, college or university to pursue college degrees. That's 88% of our senior class looking to move on to continue their education next year.
- Our students have been accepted to schools all over the country, with students going to Georgia, Georgia Tech, Georgia State, Kennesaw, Morehouse, Emory, Spellman, West Point, Michigan, Maryland, Tuskegee, Grambling, LSU, Florida, Florida State, Florida A&M, UCF, USC, Brenau, Howard, Baylor, Texas, Auburn, South Carolina, Tennessee, Alabama, Duke, Syracuse, Pennsylvania, Northwestern, NYU and the list goes on. Our North Springs students will represent us well all over the country.
- Has 6 students who will be joining our armed forces, to proudly serve our country and keep us safe.
- Has 36 students who have earned AP Scholar Status, awarded to students who receive scores of 3 or higher on three or more AP Exams.
- Has 15 students who have earned AP Scholar with Honors status, awarded to students who receive an average score of at least 3.25 on all AP exams taken, and scores of 3 or higher on 4 or more of those exams.
- Has 23 students who have earned AP Scholar with Distinction status, awarded to students who receive an average score of 3.5 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 3 or higher on 5 or more of these exams.
- Has 4 students who have earned National AP Scholar status, awarded to students who receive an average score of 4 on all AP exams, and scores of 4 or higher on 8 or more AP exams.
- 3 students who were selected to represent North Springs in the Governors Honors Program
- Has 4 students who were named National Merit Scholar Finalists
- Two University of Georgia Ramsey Scholars
- Has 18 students who earned a GPA of over 100 for all 4 years.
- Has 180 students who earned a GPA over 88 for all 4 years.
- Has 314 students who made the honor roll this year
- Has a class mean average of 89 for all 4 years.
- Has a student that has completed their first 60 hours of college, earning an AA degree before leaving high school.
- 5 students who will receive the Georgia Bi-literacy Diploma Seal.
- 11 students who will receive the Georgia International Diploma Seal
- 82 students who were inducted into the National Honor Society.
- Has 130 students that completed a College and Career Pathway
 - 21 students earned a Workforce Competency Certification in Entrepreneurship

- 33 students earned a Microsoft Office Specialist (MOS) Certification
- 1 student received Microsoft Technology Associate (MTA) Software Development certification
- 3 students received their Certified Clinical Medical Assistant (CCMA) certification
- 1 student received their Certified Medical Administrative Assistant (CMAA) certification
- And 9 students will be taking the National Certified ECG Technician certification on 5/18
- Has 21 students who have received athletic scholarships and will be continuing their athletic pursuits in college.
