Furniture and Equipment

- Purchase and install furniture and equipment to enhance and/or refresh items located at existing schools and new construction as needed
- Support options for flexible classroom furniture as replacement needs occur

Capital Seed Fund

- Support minor capital projects to implement programmatic innovations by local schools

Safety and Security

- Security camera upgrades
- Wireless communications upgrades
- Visitor and volunteer management system/ access control improvements
- Equipment and vehicles for emergency response personnel

Transportation

- School bus vehicle replacement
- Support fleet vehicle replacement
- Fleet shop maintenance equipment replacement
- Bus passenger safety enhancements
- Automated fuel management system
