



## Distance Math Program

---

**Program Description:** The Distance Math Program allows advanced Math students to complete GA Tech MATH 1554 (Linear Algebra) and MATH 2551 (Multivariable Calculus) for high school credit.

\*\*\*Students completing MATH 2551 in Spring 2019 who want to take MATH 3012 (Applied Combinatorics) and MATH 2552 (Differential Equations) in the 2019-2020 school year **must reapply** for the Distance Math Program so GA Tech can review their updated high school transcripts.\*\*\*

### Minimum Admission Requirements:

- Score of 4 or 5 on AP Calculus BC exam
- 600 Math SAT score or 27 Math ACT score
- 3.5 Academic GPA
- 3.5 Math GPA

\*GA Tech recalculates students' GPA's using a weighted 4.0 grading scale. For students taking AP or College classes, GA Tech awards an additional half point (0.5) for each course grade.

Admission to the Distance Math Program is based on a competitive review process, as there are more qualified applicants than space available. *Meeting the minimum requirements above does not guarantee admission to the program.*

### **Competitive ranges (mid 50%) of students who were offered admission for Fall 2018:**

- 5 - 8 AP and/or College classes
- Academic GPA: 4.0 - 4.6
- Academic Numeric Average: 98.36 - 100.7
- SAT (Critical Reading + Math): 1410 - 1540
- ACT Composite: 32 - 35

### **Application Checklist:**

- Go to <http://admission.gatech.edu/dualenrollment/application-and-admission> and submit your application **between May 15<sup>th</sup> and June 15<sup>th</sup>**. You must upload a copy of your transcript including Spring 2019 courses and grades when you apply. You can scan your Spring 2019 report card/transcript that will be mailed home in late May, so do not submit your application until you have that in hand. **Transcripts that are sent separately from the application will not be accepted!**
- Request appropriate AP and SAT/ACT scores to be sent from the testing agencies directly to GA Tech. GA Tech's school code for the SAT is 5248 and for the ACT is 0818. AP and SAT/ACT scores must be on file **by July 15<sup>th</sup>** in order to be considered for admission to this program. **\*\*\*You must list GA Tech as a test score recipient on the day of the AP exam to ensure that they receive your scores by the July 15<sup>th</sup> deadline!\*\*\***
- Provide Proof of Lawful Presence: <http://admission.gatech.edu/lawful-presence>. Copies of the appropriate documents listed can be emailed to [appdocs@admission.gatech.edu](mailto:appdocs@admission.gatech.edu) or faxed to 404-894-9511. You will not be registered for classes until your lawful presence is verified.
- Submit a Dual Enrollment (DE) funding application online through [www.GAFtures.org](http://www.GAFtures.org) for each semester of participation. Directions can be found here <https://goo.gl/Z3fRJJ>. **Fall 2019 Dual Enrollment funding applications must be submitted by August 15<sup>th</sup>.**

\*\*\*Students in the United States on B1 or B2 visas are not eligible for Distance Math\*\*\*
