GRADUATION CEREMONY - The Graduation Ceremony will take place at Georgia State Basketball Arena, 125 Decatur St SE, Atlanta, GA 30303. Do not bring any bags, purses and personal items with you to the ceremony location. Please leave these items with your family.

ARRIVAL TIME - Graduates **ONLY** should arrive at the venue at 11:00 AM in full regalia. Doors will open to the public at **12:15 PM**. Parents, friends and family will not be allowed in the venue until that time. The venue ushers and staff will direct your guests. Seating is first-come, first served. Holding seats will not be allowed. No one will be allowed in the venue without a ticket, including infants and children.

GRADUATION CEREMONY ETIQUETTE – Graduation is a day that students, families and friends will remember forever. It is a time to celebrate your academic achievements and say farewell. The graduates and their guests must adhere to the following:

- Remain seated during the ceremony. No cell phone talking or texting during the ceremony. Please silence your phones.
- Graduates should leave their bags/purses with family members.
- The school will not be responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- No yelling during the ceremony. Walk across the stage with dignity and class.
- No air horns or beach balls. Possession of prohibited items not be accepted.
- Anyone that causes physical damage to the venue will be fully responsible for repairs.
- Anyone impeding the flow of the program will be removed.
- No balloons in the venue.

CEREMONY ATTIRE - Students should be dressed in their Caps and Gowns upon arrival to the venue. There is no holding room to change or place bags. Graduates should have appropriate dress attire under their gown. There are no specific colors required. Students will be standing for an extended amount of time waiting to process in. **PLEASE** wear comfortable clothes under the robe, as it may get hot and comfortable shoes as they may be standing for an extended period of time.

TICKETS –Each graduate will receive 9 tickets in their package. Children and babies will need a ticket to enter the venue.

PARKING – Please be advised that parking is \$3.00 per vehicle. Guest must park in the **G Deck**. Please prepare in advance and alert your guests of this fee.

TRANSPORTATION – The MARTA stop for GSU is approximately a 2 block walk. Please use the Georgia State University stop on the East/West line. We are recommending that your friends and family car-pool, take MARTA or UBER. There will be ample parking in the G Deck, however these may be more convenient options.

FOOD & VENUE - Concession stand will be open with beverages and snacks. All items are \$1.00 Please bring **CASH**.

CEREMONY EXIT – All graduates will file out per instructions given at practice and proceed outside to meet your families for congratulations and pictures. Please meet your student outside I front of the venue.

DIPLOMA PICK-UP - During the graduation ceremony, you will receive the outer diploma cover as you walk across the stage. For the security of diploma's being given to the proper individuals, the physical diploma to go inside the cover will be given to each student during the pick-up day. Please bring a picture ID for diploma pick-up. If your parent/guardian desires to pick-up your diploma, they must bring a picture ID. Upon pick-up you will sign and verify that you have picked-up your diploma
