

Blended Opportunity Learning Time (BOLT)

Purpose: BOLT is shifting the way we use learning time by providing students with choice and voice based on their learning needs. The goal is to provide an alternate form of personalized learning time.

Focus Groups:

- Group 1 – Struggling Students (failing or near to failing a class/unit of study)
 - Students are required to attend a BOLT session for courses they are failing/near failing.
 - Students must complete BOLT Accountability Form handed out by teacher.
- Group 2 – On-Track Students (students who may need reteaching/more time to complete assignments/enrichment)
 - Students have option to attend help sessions and/or complete missing assignments.
 - Students can pick one of the options below based on their personalized needs.
- Group 3 – High Achieving Students (enrichment)
 - Students can pick one of the options below based on their personalized needs.

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Seniors:

- Seniors in good academic standing will be given the option to leave campus during BOLT.
- At beginning of the school year, seniors will complete an authorization to leave campus form that must be signed by parents and returned prior to the first BOLT day.
- If a senior is failing a class at the 6 weeks Interim Progress Report, he/she loses privilege to leave campus until next IPR comes out. If passing at next IPR, the privilege to leave campus will be reinstated.
- If seniors choose to stay on campus, they must report to a BOLT session.

Student BOLT Selections:

- Departments will ensure a variety of offerings to include help sessions, make-up sessions, and study hall.
- Students will make selections the week prior to a BOLT day on Friday during 2nd period announcements.
