How to mail in Blue Envelope:

- Please drop off or mail your cards and notes to:

- If sending multiple envelopes for one student in a larger envelope, please write the student's name on the front of ALL cards and letters.

The Do's & Don'ts of Blue Envelope:

- Send ONLY greeting cards, note cards or letters 8.5 x 11 or smaller
- Do NOT send packages
- Do NOT send anything of monetary value – we are not be responsible for gift cards, checks or cash.
- All cards and letters must be flat so that they may fit into the Blue Envelope.

When is the deadline?

- Friday, May 1, 2020. Anything later is not guaranteed to make it into the Blue Envelope.
