Dear Parent or Guardian:

Your child attends **Tri-Cities High School**, which receives Title I funds to assist students in meeting state achievement standards. Despite the progress made by our students, our school has been designated as a Focus School under the Georgia's Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) Flexibility waiver for the 2015-2016 school year. We are committed to working with our parents and stakeholders at large to address the learning needs of our students and increase their academic success.

One academic intervention initiated at the school this year is the Flexible Learning Program (FLP). The FLP offers **FREE** academic assistance such as tutoring and enhancement designed to increase academic achievement of students within our school. All students in the school are rank ordered based upon Federal and State guidelines that stipulate that students with the **greatest academic need** are to be served first, per available funding. Your child may be eligible to receive FLP services.

FLP will be offered to selected students after school, on Monday-Thursday, starting at 3:45 p.m. and ending at 5:45 p.m. Transportation will be available to transport students home after tutorial ends. If your child will not be using school transportation, please make necessary arrangements to pick up your child on time. The program will continue on January 6, 2016, and end May 5, 2016. This academic intervention program will provide your child with additional **mathematics** instruction by a highly qualified teacher.

Beginning December 14, 2015, you may officially register your child for the FLP by completing the attached registration form and submitting it directly to the school's FLP contact, Victor Scott, or you may mail the completed registration form to: Tri-Cities High School, Attn.: Victor Scott – FLP, 2575 Harris Street, East Point, GA 30344.

The school's FLP personnel will contact you via phone or letter, prior to the program's start date, to notify you if your child has been selected to receive the FLP services, or if your child has been placed on a waiting list due to capacity. If your child is selected, the FLP personnel will notify you of the child's FLP service schedule. You will be informed should there be a modification to the FLP service schedule.

Parent meetings will be advertised and held to provide more information on the FLP services offered at our school. These meetings will provide you the opportunity to view first-hand the FLP services being provided to your child as well as provide you with a copy of our FLP plan. You will be contacted by FLP teachers and staff on a regular basis concerning your child's enrollment and academic progress.
