College Calendar Check list for Seniors:

OCTOBER

- Take the SAT or ACT exam, if necessary.
- If you haven't already, begin preparing your college applications. Check with the colleges to find out when materials must be postmarked.
- Continue to work on admission application essays.
- Continue to visit college campuses.
- Research sources for outside funding and/or scholarships.
- Take a Career Assessment test. All seniors will be taking the Career Exploration Program test (ASVAB) on October 15, 2014. The ASVAB IS NOT A MILITARY TEST.

College Calendar Check list for Juniors:

OCTOBER

- Take the Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test (PSAT). The test will be administered on October 15, 2014.
- Attend college fairs and financial aid/parent nights.

College Affordability: Using your college's Net Price Calculator

The Net Price Calculator is a tool that students can use to estimate their "net price" to attend a particular college or university.

Net price is the difference between the “sticker” price (full cost) to attend a specific college, minus any grants and scholarships for which students may be eligible. Sticker price includes direct charges (tuition and fees, room and board) and indirect costs (books and supplies, transportation, and personal expenses).
