

Requirements for Entering the Fulton County School System at the Middle School Level

No registrations will be processed prior to the start of the school year without the following documents.

1. **Two health certificates** are required to attend school in the state of Georgia:

- **Immunization Certificate – Georgia Form 3231**

Georgia state law requires students attending school to be age appropriately immunized with all required vaccines at the time of first entry in a Georgia school. A “new entrant” is a child entering Georgia schools for the first time or returning to Georgia schools after an absence of more than 12 months or one school year. Immunization information must be on the Georgia Department of Human Resources form 3231, available through the Fulton County Department of Health and Wellness (see reverse) or local physicians.

Children entering 6th grade must have 2 doses of varicella or proof of the disease, 2 doses each of measles and mumps and 1 dose of rubella (or 2 doses of the combined MMR vaccine).

Children entering 7th grade (born on or after January 1, 2002) **and new entrants to GA schools in grades 8-12** must have received one dose of Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis) and one dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV4).

- **Certificate of Vision, Hearing, Dental and Nutrition Screening – Georgia Form 3300**

Any child entering a Georgia school for the first time must have a certificate of vision, hearing, dental and nutritional screening.

Students starting school during the school year who are from out of state or have been out of a Georgia school for a period of over twelve months are eligible for a thirty day immunization grace period and/or 120 day vision, hearing, dental and nutrition screening grace period.

2. **Birth Certificate – government issued** (students born outside the USA may present a passport)

3. **Verification of residency** in the attendance area, bearing the name of the parent/guardian and the address listed. **Must include a current water or electric bill AND one of the following:**

- a. copy of home mortgage statement or current apartment lease
- b. valid driver’s license or state ID
- c. home sales contract
- d. homeowner’s/renter’s insurance card
- e. current bank statement
- f. current paycheck
- g. current HOA bill

4. **Student’s Social Security Card**

Social security numbers are voluntary, but the card is **required** if use of the social security number is desired. Waivers are available for those not wishing to use it or who do not have one.

5. **Academic Records**

Proof of grade placement is required, along with records from previous school indicating enrollment in any special programs (IEP, gifted, etc.) **7th and 8th grade students must provide discipline records.**
