5:55 pm Meeting called to order by S. Gregory

- Presented agenda and gave everyone a brief moment to review agenda
- Wants to add a Discussion Item to the agenda to discuss having a future SGC meeting at an off site location
- Added a 3<sup>rd</sup> Action Item which was to approve the minutes from the January meeting

S. C-James motioned to approve the agenda and J. Lewis second; agenda was approved

S. Gregory gave everyone a few minutes to review the minutes from the January meeting and the February "meeting"

- S. C-James noticed a few typos in the minutes
  - The letter 'e' is missing in the words "committees" and "replacements" in the January minutes
  - The year 2019 should be replaced for the Declarations period

S. C-James motioned to approve the minutes from January and February meetings and Belser second; minutes were approved

S. Gregory reviewed meeting norms

S. Gregory stated that he was going to reach out to Gina Foster to see if she could conduct SGC Committee Training at the school on Wednesday, March 20

S. Gregory gave an overview of the South/AZ Cross Council that was held on Tuesday, February 19 from 6:00pm – 7:30pm

- Attendees were S. Gregory and B. Allen
- Discussed the Exceptional Council list; this list is point driven
  - There are 12 items or areas on this list worth a total of 12 points (each item is assigned 1 point; if achieved)
  - As of that meeting CCMS was compliant in 8 areas; we have 8 points
  - 9 points are needed to satisfy Fulton county schools requirements
  - Spoke with Adams to see if the Strategic Monitoring Tool will be ready soon so that it can be posted to the school's website; this will give us the 9 points we need to be in compliance

- We also have an opportunity for another point to be earned if we have 6 SGC meetings that meet quorum

S. Gregory provided a brief update on the upcoming SGC elections

- The goal is to have 15% parent involvement and 70% staff involvement
- McCoy is running un-opposed as teacher

S. Gregory stated that he will remind Principal Adams to have the Strategic Monitoring Tool done before the end of the 2018 – 2019 school year

S. Gregory requested an update from Committee Chairs

- Community Outreach
  - S. C-James stated that she does not have an update as she is waiting to receive the Committee Training that is needed and required
  - B. Allen provided an update on a possible partnership with Chick Fila on Camp Creek; basically she is waiting to receive the contract and information from their contact
- Budget/Finance
  - J. Lewis also stated that she did not have an updated to provide as she did not want to proceed before receiving the required Committee Training
  - The budget for the 2019 – 2020 school year was approved in time for the deadline

S. Gregory added a Discussion item:

- Proposed having one of our SGC meetings at an off campus location; suggested locations were Creekside housing community and Welcome All recreational facility
- Proposed having a possible meeting with the SGC members one day during the week of March 25 to further discuss this possibility

S. Gregory stated there would not be a Principal Update; Principal Adams was not in attendance

S. Gregory led discussion to set the agenda for the April SGC meeting

- Added having the SGC meeting at an off campus location
- SGC Elections results
- Training Update
