- I. Call to Order:** Chair, Erica Reddick called the meeting to order with the roll call of the SGC Members.

As a team, we must decide how we will measure student success. Council discussed why literacy is a current focus area; explained that the focus derived from EOG testing data and an analysis conducted by teachers of students' performance outside of the state assessment. Mrs. Griffin suggested surveying what "student achievement" means to staff to align expectations. Mr. Aucoin recommended that we begin to consider community outreach student achievement; recommending a protocol that we can use to have meaningful discussion in which is willing train people to conduct. Campbell has recommended inviting the PTSA President to the next meeting and feeder schools to join in this action.

- II. Strategic Support Circles** Mr. Campbell explained the rationale behind this effort for intensive support schools (69 or below on CCRPI). Trend data was displayed to support the "why" behind Support Circles. Support Circles provide schools with an opportunity to have collaborative dialogue school and district representatives regarding school needs/challenge and solutions to improve student learning and success.
