1. The Parenting Center at CCMS is located in Room A (on the main hallway) of the school. This is a room specifically designated for our parents. The Title I Passport Workshop for parents will be held in the Parenting Center.

2. The CCMS Parenting Center is a room at the school that is utilized by the parent. The Center is used to:

- Provide supplemental resources for eligible Title I parents & students at COMES.
- Inform the parents about Parental Workshops, Meeting, Events, and Activities in the school. Deliver parent training, small classes, and tutorial.
- Share opportunities about volunteering in the school.
- Format letters, flyers, newsletter, and other documents to be sent home to parents.

- The Parent Liaison plans and conducts monthly workshops for parents.
- The Parent Liaison maintains a list of specific assignments for parents to perform as volunteers.
- The Parent Liaison provides parent with their Title I Information, Home Access Code, assists parents with resume writing, provide job information, coordinates coat drive, and food drive.
