

Good Evening 8th Grade Parents and Guardians,

Eighth-grade students at Camp Creek Middle School will take the Milestone Assessment beginning Monday, April 15 – Friday, April 19. The Georgia Milestones is a comprehensive summative assessment program that measures how well students have learned the knowledge and skills outlined in the content standards in the core content areas of language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies. It is designed to provide information about student achievement and readiness to move on to the 9th grade.

The Milestone schedule is as follows:

- *Monday, April 15- ELA - Section 1*
- *Tuesday, April 16- ELA - Section 2*
- *Wednesday, April 17- ELA - Section 3*
- *Thursday, April 18 – Math Section 1*
- *Friday, April 19, Math Section 2*

To ensure the testing environment is secure and free of distractions; the following procedures must be followed by all students.

- *No cell phones or personal electronic equipment is allowed in the testing site/classroom. This includes smartwatches, tablets, iPads, cell phones, and any other equipment.*
- *Students must store their purses/pocketbooks in their lockers. No outside bags will be allowed in the classroom during the Milestones.*
- *Students that violate any testing policy or procedure will be subject disciplinary action in accordance with the Fulton County Schools' Student Code of Conduct.*

Testing reminders:

- *Students should come to school by 8:45 am with a fully charged Chromebook.*
- *Students should get a good night's sleep each night before testing.*
- *Students should eat a healthy breakfast each morning.*
- *Students should come prepared with a book to read after the entire testing administration is complete.*
- *No food or drink is permitted during testing.*

Teachers and students have worked extremely hard this school year in preparation for the Georgia Milestones and we expect to see an increase in Georgia Milestones scores. Parents thank you so much for entrusting the faculty of Camp Creek Middle School with the honor of educating your student.
