Our school is committed to the safety and education of all our students. We also want to clearly communicate with parents about safety issues when they arise.

Today, one of our students brought a BB gun to school that resembled a hand gun. The student was immediately questioned and searched, and the BB gun was confiscated. At no time was the BB gun brought out at school or used to threaten other students. Nonetheless, this incident is a violation of law, and criminal charges will be filed in addition to school-imposed disciplinary measures. The student involved will be subject to consequences under the Fulton County Schools Student Code of Conduct regarding Category 2 weapons on a school campus.

Please discuss this incident with your student and emphasize that it is against the law to bring weapons of any type to school. This includes BB guns, pellet guns or Airsoft guns. Also, please emphasize the importance of telling an adult or a faculty member if there is a weapon at school. In this way, we are all working together to keep Camp Creek Middle School safe.
