Who can set up an eWallet?

- Parents
- Grandparents
- Aunts/Uncles

Who Can an eWallet be set up for?

- Students
- Teachers
- School

Why would you want to set up an eWallet?

- If you don't have cash to send in, set your student up an eWallet.
- If you want to give your teachers a gift certificate, eWallet is the way to go.
- Does a company want to give every student in your school a book? Have them set up an eWallet and charge each child's book against it.
- It helps eliminate a student losing money or spending it on something different.
- You don't have to worry about your student bringing home change.

How many eWallets can one person have?

- A person can have as many as they want. It is no different than having several gift cards.

How are parents charged for eWallet purchases?

A preauthorization charge will appear on the credit card account in the amount parents select as the eWallet spending limit. Parents will only be charged for what is purchased at the fair (up to the spending limit they selected). On the last day of the in-school book fair, any unspent funds will be released back to the credit card on file.

Can parents add additional funds to an existing eWallet?

Yes, additional funds can be added to the eWallet at any time. Parents can also delete eWallets, and any unspent funds would be returned to their credit card.
