Suicide Prevention and Awareness

In the United States, suicide is the second leading cause of death for young people ages 10 – 24. It is also one of the leading causes of PREVENTABLE death. We lose approximately 130 young people in this age group to suicide each week. FOUR out FIVE teens who attempt suicide have given clear warning signs. That means that in 80% of these cases, we have an opportunity to intervene and possibly save a young person who is at-risk. September is Suicide Prevention Awareness Month. Thank you for supporting this initiative and continuing the conversation at home with your students.

If you know someone who is struggling with suicidal thoughts, be a good friend and help them ask for help from a trusted adult. Here at school we have a school counselor, social worker and psychologist who are available to provide help.
