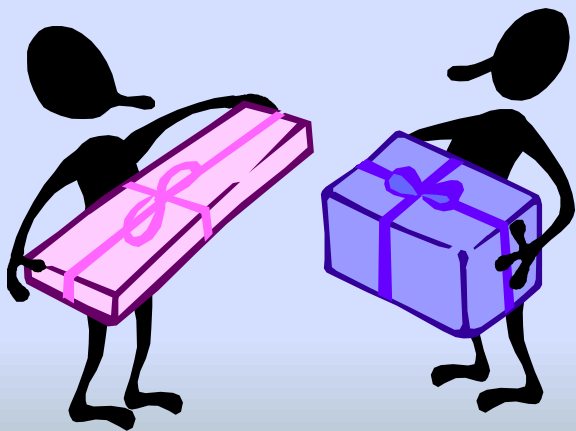

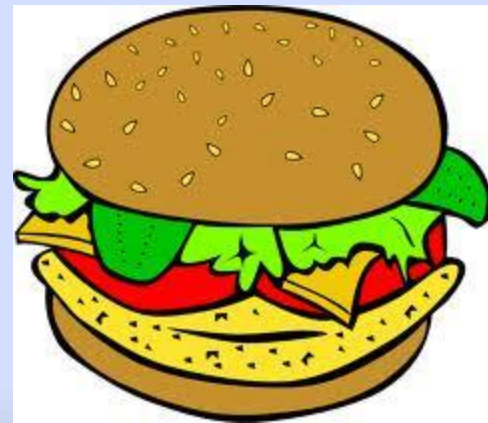
Knitting Club
