



Ridgeview Non-Uniform for Pay Dress Code

Non-uniform attire, in general, should adhere to Fulton County Schools dress expectations. Specific guidelines are listed below & are provided as additional guidance. The list is not exhaustive or comprehensive.

All decisions concerning appropriateness of attire are left to teacher & Ridgeview Administration discretion. Any student whose attire is not appropriate will be provided a change of clothes, if available, or will be required to call a parent/guardian to bring a change of clothes swiftly & immediately.

Pants, shorts, skirts, skorts

- May be any color or style, but may not be tight-fitting nor excessively baggy
- Must be worn at the natural waist line
- No shreds, holes, etc.
- Shorts, skirts, or skorts must be at least finger-tip length
- Leggings are ok if the shirt covers down to the mid-thigh

Shirts or sweatshirts

- May be any color or style
- Must cover the shoulder
- Necklines/collars must not droop excessively & should stay around the collar-bone area

Shoes

- May be any style for normal wear
- Appropriate athletic shoes are required for PE
- No bedroom slippers
- No high heels
- No Sandals

Socks

- Go crazy!

General

- No apparel which designates gangs or similar organizations, no drugs or alcohol, no weapons, no inappropriate language, nor any images that refer to any of these things.
- Pajamas may not be worn to school.
