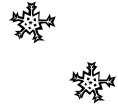

Hardship Transfer Application Window to Open January 1

An application will be available beginning January 1 for parents who wish to apply for a 2017-2018 hardship transfer for their child(ren) or to renew a current hardship to another Fulton elementary, middle or high school. Hardship transfer requests are those that relate to medical reasons, curriculum differences, childcare situations or for employees' children. Parents will use an online form to enter and submit their information. Hard copy applications will not be accepted with the exception of medical transfers which require pertinent medical provider's signatures and documentation. The online application for hardship transfers will go live on the district website beginning January 1, with a deadline of February 28, 2017, by 4:30 p.m. All requests must be submitted by this date and time. Schools participating in open enrollment, a separate transfer process that allows students to move to a school with available space, will be announced in early May.
