- If an individual wants to reach out with a question, concern or general thought they should reach out to the Outreach and Communications Chair (Mr. Smallwood)
- Mrs. Geathers is following up to see if the council is allowed to ask questions of speakers

We then proceeded to have a data talk

At our last strategic planning meeting we condensed our data and thoughts from the last meeting and at the leadership team meeting into 6 take-away points. Teachers looked at the same 6 points and used a protocol called “dotmocracy”. Council members put an orange sticker next to most urgent items and black dot next to somewhat urgent.

Council and teachers found that 3rd, 4th and 5th grade students performing below state and county on standardized tests, the number of students that are at or above grade level decreasing as student’s progress K-5, and the number of suspensions as the most urgent areas of need
