5:07 Call to order

- Reviewed flex funding
- Bought AR, Nearpod, furniture for staff development room, and 40 chromebooks
- \$16,000 left over after purchases
- Geathers wants to use some of the funds to pay for teacher training over the summer and field trips for each grade level connected to strategic plan
  - Ferguson will help to plan STEM related field trips

- Ex. Science Guy, Chattahoochee Nature Center, etc.

- About \$8000 for summer training
- About \$7000 for field trips across all grade levels

  - Dec 19 4-6 indoor beautification day
- Sutton – 22 fifth grade students below grade level
  - Is there a way to incorporate a reading remediation class?
  - Geathers stated that remediation should be happening through EIP
  - Need parental support to get students to Saturday School, extended day, tutorial
  - Harris suggested phonics support. Geathers reminded that all of that is embedded in county purchased iRead
  - Create a list of volunteer times and slots where parents can come work with students
    - Need to do a specific ask for reading support in Friday memos (especially for retired teachers) – suggestion to use Google forms or Microsoft forms for signing up
  - Upper grades kids could read with and mentor lower grades kids
