

Immunization & Vision, Hearing, Dental and Nutrition Screening Information

Two health certificates are required to attend school in the state of Georgia:

1. A certificate of immunization (form #3231) or a notarized “Affidavit of Religious Exemption” or Medical letter and 3231 indicating exemption.
2. Certificate of Vision, Hearing, Dental and Nutrition Screening (form 3300 revised 2013).

Required of all new entrants and rising 7th grade students

All rising 7th grade students and new entrants (children of any age entering Georgia schools for the first time or returning to Georgia schools after being out of the system for a year) are required to meet the following requirements:

1. Two doses of measles vaccine
2. Two doses of mumps vaccine
3. One dose of rubella vaccine or laboratory proof of immunity against measles, mumps or rubella.
4. Two doses of the varicella (chicken pox) vaccine or documentation of disease or laboratory proof of immunity.
5. 1 dose of Meningococcal conjugate vaccine
6. 1 dose of Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis) vaccine

Screenings are available through your private health provider or the health department.
